Pastor's Desk

The Mind of Christ - It starts here first.

James berates his readers for the way they treat each other for their disagreements, judgements, and their selfishness. I can hear us all thinking 'Wow, that must have been an awful place – I'm glad it's not that way here...' When we ask the Spirit to reveal what our hearts are really like, we become less judgmental of the early believers that James was writing to.

We get so tied up in what we are doing for Christ and then judge what we think others are doing or not doing, that our heart becomes judgmental and hard. Our life following King Jesus isn't about doing more but about becoming. Becoming day by day more like Him, every moment reflecting Him, living in step with His Spirit so His life flows from us in surprising and supernatural unexplainable ways. The fire that burns within us should be bringing warmth, comfort, light and attracting the cold, prisoner, lame and blind both spiritually and physically.

The Western Church, it seems, has become a task-driven organisation which fuels resentment and an unfulfilled spirit, yet Jesus was never that way. He lived a life in the Spirit willing to be interrupted, never in a hurry and always having a non-anxious presence no matter what was happening around Him. Paul in Philippians calls us to have the mind of Christ – but what was He like? Gentle and humble (Matthew 11:29). It requires no explanation just a serious audit of our own lives.

Easter 2022


